

2009 VSBA Signs of Success Poster Session

Reserve your spot by October 1, 2009



The Virginia School Boards Association is once again inviting all 134 school divisions across the state to participate in “Signs of Success.”

To take part, divisions are asked to create and submit an poster illustrating their favorite success story. The success can be large or small—no achievement is insignificant, as long as your division wants to share it and celebrate it with others.

The posters will be displayed in a designated “Signs of Success” location, showcasing the outstanding ideas, achievements and programs taking place in our public schools. This poster session will last the duration of the Conference.

To participate, follow these simple steps:

1. Create your poster design using a 22” x 28” sheet of foamcore board.
2. Include the division name and contact information (name, position, phone number, e-mail address) in a 3” x 5” space in the lower right front corner of the poster.
3. Reserve your spot in the “Signs of Success” display by October 1. (Your spot must be reserved in advance so that easels may be ordered.) To make a reservation:
Send a digital photo of the completed poster to Gina Patterson at gina@vsba.org. You will also need to send a check to the VSBA office for \$15 to cover the cost of the easel rental. It will be your responsibility for delivering the poster to the Conference Registration Desk immediately upon your arrival in Williamsburg.
4. Before leaving the Conference, pick up your poster from the “Signs of Success” room location. Please note that all participants are responsible for removing their poster. VSBA is unable to return any remaining posters.
