### MIDDLE SCHOOL

For students taking civics and economics.

### DAVID RICARDO

For students enrolled in a one-semester general economics course, or economics-related course that is not labeled as AP, IB, honors, or college-level.

### ADAM SMITH

For students enrolled in any AP, IB, honors, college-level, or two-semester general economics course.

## HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

Beginning JANUARY 1st, teachers\* can go to [www.econchallenge.org](http://www.econchallenge.org) to register teams for the online competition.

There are no fees to enter, and no travel is required for the EconChallenge Online.

Winning teams in each division from around the state are invited to Richmond for the State Championship.

The state champs in the high school division will progress to the Regional Competition with the opportunity to advance to the National Competition in New York City with all travel expenses paid.
