## 2020 VSBA Food For Thought Competition Winners Announced Winners Recognized at a Virtual Awards Ceremony

**July 23, 2020 –** Six school divisions received top honors in the 2020 Virginia School Boards Association (VSBA) Food For Thought Competition. Winning divisions were recognized during a virtual awards ceremony. The competition was created in 2012 to educate, engage, and empower school leaders to address childhood hunger and provide all students in Virginia with healthier, more nutritious school meals. This is the ninth year the awards were given out. The awards were sponsored by ABM.
