2023 VSBA High School Student Video Contest Winners Announced

Charlottesville, VA – The Virginia School Boards Association’s (VSBA) 12th annual student video contest challenged high school students across Virginia to create a 30-second video centered around the theme “We Are Better United Than Divided.” The first, second and third place winners, selected out of 21 submissions, were announced today at the opening general session of the VSBA Annual Convention in Williamsburg, VA, and the videos were shown to the convention’s attendees.
