Virginia School Boards Association President Makes Roadshow Stop at Isle of Wight County Public Schools

As part of the visit, students from the IWCS Culinary Arts program will prepare refreshments using locally sourced ingredients. These culinary creations will not only demonstrate the talents of IWCS students but will also promote the importance of supporting local agriculture and sustainable food practices.
