#### What's New This Year?

The 13th Annual VSBA Food for Thought Competition is getting a fresh new focus! Instead of broad categories, we're spotlighting Meal Access to Fight Hunger with three targeted subcategories:

- Breakfast Programs Helping students start their day with the nutrition they need.
- Afterschool Meal Programs Ensuring access to meals beyond the school day.
- Mental Health and Nutrition Initiatives Supporting overall wellness through food security.

This new structure gives school divisions the opportunity to showcase their most impactful initiatives in a more meaningful way!

#### When is the deadline?

The deadline for all entries is Friday, May 30, 2025.

How do I submit an entry?

#### How many entries can we submit?

- Each school division may submit one entry per category (up to three total).
- You can also choose to submit just one single entry-there's no minimum requirement.

#### How will I know my entry has been received?

You will receive a confirmation email for each entry you submit.

### What if our school division won last year?

You may not submit the same project again. However, you may submit in the same category if your division has initiated a new program.
