These local leaders voluntarily take on the significant responsibility of governing multi-million-dollar school divisions, making decisions that shape educational opportunities while upholding the core values of our democracy.

We encourage you to use this month to celebrate your local school board's accomplishments. Engage community leaders, business partners, and civic organizations to join in your recognition efforts.

Within this toolkit you'll find dozens of ideas that may be used to celebrate School Board Appreciation Month. Don't miss out on this opportunity to celebrate your school board members.

Sample News Release

This news release can be submitted to the local media for publication. Be sure to add information about special ceremonies or events you are planning for your board members. You may want to include an accompanying "fact sheet" about your division and/or board members. Include photos, if available.

Sample Letter to the Editor

This sample letter can be submitted to your local newspaper for publication. Use the letter to inform the community about School Board Appreciation Month and to send a positive message about public education and your division's accomplishments. You could also ask a parent, booster or business partner to sign or co-sign the letter.

Public Service Announcements

Contact local radio stations to arrange the announcing and placement of your public service announcement (PSA). This sample radio script can be customized to include your division information.

Sample Opinion Column

This article can be adapted for use in your division newsletter, as an article in your local newspaper, as a letter to the editor or as the foundation of a speech.

Draft Proclamation

A sample resolution that your city council or county board of supervisors can adapt/adopt and pass to proclaim February as "School Board Appreciation Month."

Suggested Activities and Tips

Celebrate School Board Appreciation Month

"From Strong Roots Come Endless Possibilities"

Show your appreciation for the school board members who nurture the foundation of public education! Use the ideas below to spark creativity and community involvement throughout February.

Showcase & Share

- **Create a short appreciation video** featuring students, teachers, parents, and community members sharing what they value about their school board.
- **Share your story** send a press release or letter to the editor (samples included) highlighting how your board supports student success.
- **Go on air!** Partner with local radio or podcast hosts for a quick interview or public service announcement.
- Launch a social media spotlight series introducing each board member with fun facts, quotes, and their "why" for serving.

Celebrate & Connect

- Host an Appreciation Reception at your February board meeting. Invite local businesses or restaurants to co-sponsor light refreshments.
- "Adopt a Board Member" have schools or student groups present handmade cards, videos, or art pieces of gratitude.
- **Student art or essay contest:** "What Makes Public Education Grow Strong?" Display entries in the school lobby or local library.
- Plant a tree or flower garden dedicated to your school board a living symbol of "strong roots and endless possibilities"

Engage the Community

- Request proclamations from your city council, chamber of commerce, or local organizations recognizing School Board Appreciation Month.
- Invite civic and business clubs (Kiwanis, Rotary, Lions, etc.) to host your board members at a breakfast or luncheon.
- Ask local businesses to post appreciation messages on their marquees or digital displays.
- **Publish a digital brochure or webpage** featuring photos, service years, and community impact stories of your school board members.

🌲 Promote & Publicize

- Add a homepage banner or scrolling announcement to your division website celebrating School Board Appreciation Month.
- Feature board highlights in your school newsletter, social media pages, or email updates.
- **Hang posters and banners** in schools, libraries, and public spaces with the 2026 theme: From Strong Roots Come Endless Possibilities.
- Encourage handwritten notes of thanks from students, staff, and families simple gestures that mean so much!

Inspire & Involve Students

- **Invite student groups** to perform at a February board meeting choir, band, or spoken word presentations.
- **Honor your board members** at a school event let them toss the first ball, blow the whistle, or announce the opening of a game.
- **Host a "Board Member for a Day"** event where students shadow a board member to learn about leadership and governance.
- Start a student-led interview series for your school's news program or podcast, featuring board members' insights and experiences.

♦ Inspire & Involve Students

- Send a daily quote during the first week of February using the enclosed "Education Quotes" sheet –
 post on social media or share via email.
- Encourage local media coverage that highlights the dedication and service of your school board members.
- End the month with a thank-you video or social post featuring messages of gratitude from across your division.

Tip: Remember – creativity and sincerity matter most. Whether through a small gesture or a big event, every expression of appreciation strengthens the roots of public education.
